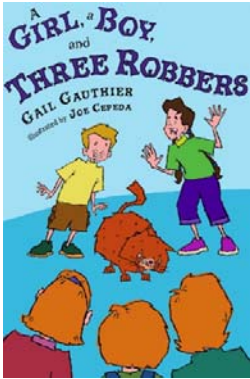
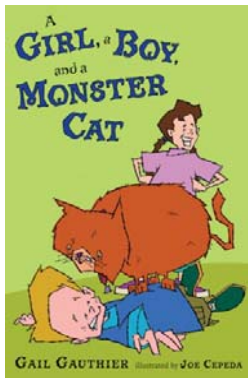


After Hours...

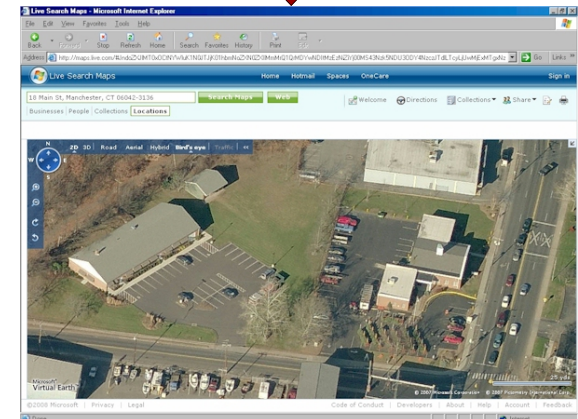

of the properties as they can be seen on line. These photographs provide valuable information before we ever set foot on the property as they provide an overview of what the site is like. See if your business or house is shown.

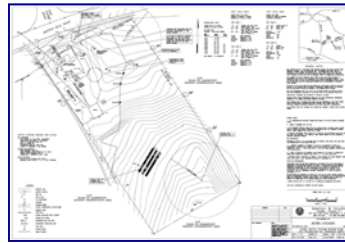

On the Boards... Parking Improvements



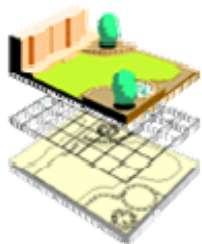
