On the Boards... Facility Improvements



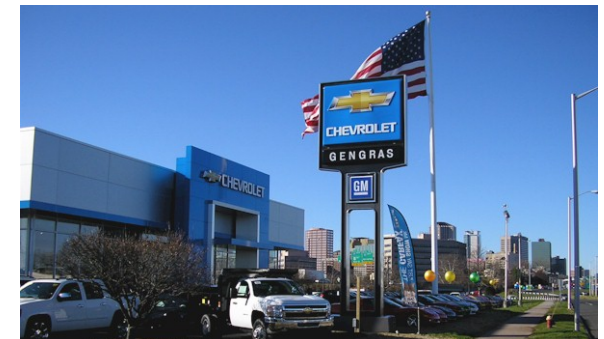
