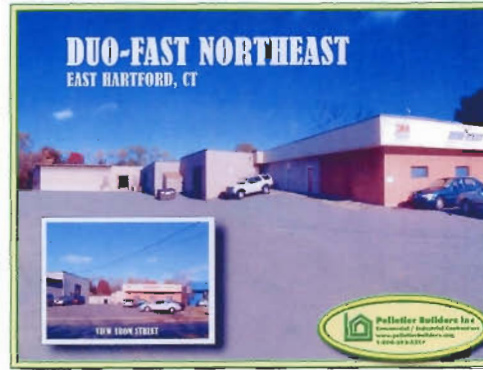

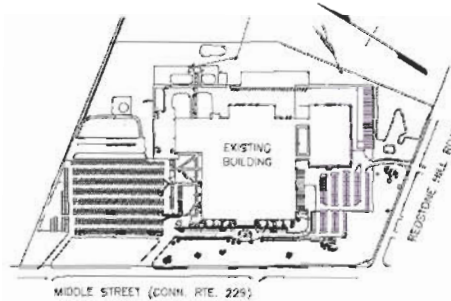
Building Expansion...
